Chinese New Year Gala 2025

30th anniversary of official relations between the Principality of Monaco and the People's Republic of China

The hundred or so guests were able to taste the menu specially prepared for the occasion by the chefs of the Fairmont Monte-Carlo Hotel, accompanied by the traditional Chinese rice alcohol Wuliangye.

Numerous activities highlighting Chinese culture punctuated the evening, including the Dragon Dance, a demonstration of Chinese calligraphy, traditional music with a guzheng and Sheng concert, traditional dances in period costumes from the Han (206 BC - 220) and Tang (618-907) dynasties, and even more contemporary Chinese variety songs.

The cultural and artistic activities of the Gala were rich and colorful. Guests were also able to enjoy the choir of Chinese students from Collège Charles III, shows to the rhythm of popular international songs, live drawings by the artist FABEN, as well as a fashion show of creations from the house AMC Haute Couture Monaco before the DJ took over to get the guests dancing.

This event combined culture and gastronomy in an elegant and refined atmosphere. A magnificent evening that ended smoothly and where all the guests were able to leave with many prestigious gifts.
